BC EMALB issues 3 year First Responder Licence

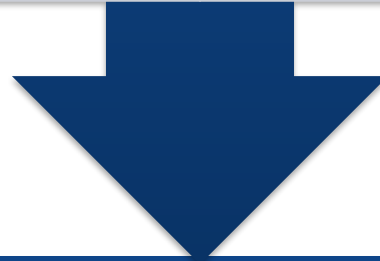
